In compliance with the federal Student Right-To-Know and Campus Security Act of 1990 (P.L 101-542) and its 2008 amendments, Collin College makes its completion and transfer-out rates available to all current and prospective students. For this report, consistent with provisions of the legislation, students who entered Collin College in the fall term as first-time, full-time, degree seeking students were tracked over a three-year period (150% of normal time to degree completion) of their initial entry into Collin College. Their completion and transfer-out rates are presented in the following report. Collin College also submits the data to the US Department of Education's National Center for Education Statistics in the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System's (IPEDS) Graduation Rate Survey (GRS). "Student Right-to-Know" provisions of the law require that graduation rates be disaggregated by gender, by major racial and ethnic categories, and by various types of federal financial aid status.

It should be noted that these rates do not represent the success rates of the entire student population at Collin College. Rather, they relate ONLY to first-time, full-time, degreeseeking students enrolled in the summer and fall of a given federal reporting year. These rates exclude student outcomes that occur after the three-year tracking period.

Based on the IPEDS definition, a completer is a student who was awarded a certificate or degree within 150 percent of normal time to completion. A transfer-out is a student who transferred to another post-secondary institution within 150 percent of normal time to completion who did not earn a degree or certificate within that time frame.
