



International Student Office Letter of Guarantee

F-1 international students are required to demonstrate sufficient financial support to cover both living expenses (such as housing, meals, transportation) and educational costs (including tuition, books, and fees) while studying in the United States. Collin College requires all F-1 international student applicants, who are being sponsored, to submit a letter of guarantee showing financial support. Applicants are required to submit financial documentation that equals or exceeds one full year of educational and living expenses. An English translated original bank statement dated within six months of applications deadline, showing the total estimated funds in U.S. dollars (USD), is required in addition to this form.
