



PARAMEDIC ESTIMATED COST

Emergency Medical Services Education



This is the standard estimated cost for the Emergency Medical Technician program. This estimate includes a \$2 per credit hour mandatory student fee.

Tuition, fees, textbooks, etc. are payable by semester. Costs may vary, depending on students' uniform & equipment choices)

Tuition

- \$2,211 In County (\$67/credit hour)
- \$4,191 Out of County (\$127/credit hour)
- \$6,666 Out of State (\$202/credit hour)

Note: The EMS Paramedic program is 42 hours; you will receive 9 credit hours for your NREMT or Texas certification.
