This course does NOT meet the requirement for the 40-hour Crisis Intervention Training (Course #1850)</i></p> <p>Student Prerequisites:</p> <p>(a) To qualify for a Mental Health Officer proficiency certificate, an applicant must meet the following requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Currently appointed as a peace officer, county jailer, or justice of the peace; (ii) At least two years' experience as a peace officer, county jailer, or justice of the peace; (iii) If not currently a commissioned peace officer or county jailer, an applicant must meet the current enrollment standards; (iv) If an applicant is a commissioned peace officer or county jailer, an applicant must not ever have had a license or certificate issued by the commission suspended or revoked; (v) If an applicant is a commissioned peace officer or county jailer, an applicant must have met the continuing education requirements for the previous training cycle; (vi) Successful completion of a training course in emergency first aid and lifesaving techniques (Red Cross or equivalent); and (vii) Successful completion of the current mental health officer training course and pass the approved examination for mental health officer proficiency. <p>(b) The effective date of this section is January 14, 2010.</p>	24	March 23-25, 2026 December 7-9, 2026	\$175.00

Beginning in 1990, the Collin College Law Enforcement Academy worked in partnership with the Collin County Sheriff's Office and other area law enforcement agencies of Collin County to provide cost-effective and quality training programs to law enforcement. Starting in September 2018, the Collin College Law Enforcement Academy, in partnership with the cities of Allen and McKinney, began the operation of the new Collin College Public Safety Training Center. We aim to provide essential, timely, cost-effective law enforcement training at entry and in-service levels. Our vision is to train the best peace, correctional, and telecommunicators nationwide.

The Collin College Law Enforcement Academy provides training for police, civilian, and volunteer employees of bona fide law enforcement agencies. We are an accredited police academy licensed by the Texas Commission of Law Enforcement (TCOLE). Our classes typically are open only to bona fide law enforcement personnel sponsored by their employing agency. Our Basic Police Academy classes are open only to individuals sponsored by a bona fide law enforcement agency or those who have made an application to and have been approved by the Academy Director. All other course programs are closed to law enforcement.
