
A Contributor is the parent or parents of a dependent student as well as a spouse of an independent student where applicable.


Students without a Social Security Number* should <u>never</u> use this process to apply for an FSA ID <u>unless</u> they are from the Freely Associated States.


*Having a Social Security Number is one of the eligibility requirements for receiving Federal student aid. Students from the Freely Associated States are the only exception.














If You Aren't Presented Questions If FAFSA couldn't generate identity verification questions for you or you answered them incorrectly, a yellow banner will display. You will be notified on the account creation confirmation page that you need to take additional steps for FAFSA to verify your identity. You will receive a "Verify Your Identity" email from FAFSA with these next steps. You must forward the email that you receive to the email address that is provided in it (the email) and attach a copy of the required documents from the list on the next page, plus a completed and signed attestation form. Important: Once you create an account, you'll immediately be able to access and complete the FAFSA form by logging in with your username and password combination (FSA ID). You'll have access to the 2025–26 FAFSA form while you're completing the mandatory identity verification process. IMPORTANT: You can't create another new StudentAld.gov account to bypass a failed verification.

IN SUMMARY

 New users without an SSN who request a StudentAid.gov account and cannot validate their identity using the knowledge-based questions (as generated by TransUnion) <u>must still complete the manual</u> process to validate their identity.

However, they will <u>not</u> have to wait to have their identity validation completed before they can use their account username and password to access and complete the online 2025-26 FAFSA form.

Individuals can check the status of their identity validation on their StudentAid.gov dashboard. If the status on the "Personal Information" page of their Account Settings is "no-SSN" with a green check icon, individuals are able to progress to the FAFSA form.

Please note that this status is the same for those who have completed the validation process and those who are temporarily allowed to enter and complete the form.

Individuals who are currently waiting for results from the Department do not need to resubmit any documentation to complete the identity validation process.

SUMMARY Cont.

- If an individual's StudentAid.gov account <u>does not show</u> a status of "no-5SN" with a green check icon
 and they have not received an email notifying them of this temporary change, they will need to
 follow the instructions for individuals without an SSN to create a StudentAid.gov account, as they are
 not currently in the Department's system.
- The Department encourages all users without an SSN to complete the identity validation process without delay, even after the student's FAFSA form is submitted.
- If an individual without an SSN continues to have issues logging in to StudentAid.gov, they should contact the <u>Federal Student Aid Information Center</u> (https://studentaid.gov/help-center/contact) for assistance with signing in to their account.
