Checklist for Dependents/Spouses Whose Qualifying Veteran is MIA, KIA, or Deceased Due to Service-Related Injury/Illness

1st time using Hazlewood benefits:

- Texas Hazlewood Act Exemption Application - Signed and dated by student
Initial Application
Is student a Chapter 33? YES NO
Chapter 33 can only be used with Hazlewood if CH 33 percentage is less than 100%.
Texas Residency - MUST be either in-county or out-of-county.
DD214 - Member 2 or 4 copy - Verify first if veteran is eligible for Hazlewood in order for the dependent to be eligible.
Check Home of Record or Place of Entry (TX), as well as type of discharge (Honorable/General). Veteran must have also served at least 181 days, excluding training.
Veteran may also be eligible if they were a Texas resident at time of entry
A DD Form 214 may be obtained from the National Archives: DD 214 Online
If Veteran died while in service - D1300 Report of Casualty.
If Veteran died AFTER discharge- Letter from the VA confirming the death was related to service.
Birth Certificate or Tax Return - To show the relationship to the veteran.
Marriage certificate and birth certificate can be used when it is step-child.
VA Certificate of Eligibility (COE) - Access COE Online
(only if dependent is Chapter 33 - not veteran).
Student enrolled in classes? YES NO
ONLY Chapter 33/Post 9/11 students MUST be enrolled in order to post exemption.

Students will need to create an account and print out their hours.
Selective Service - Check to see if student filed a FAFSA. If so, notate on RHACOMM. If student did not file a FAFSA, must sign SSSSTAT form (males only).
