#### 1. Collin College Hosts Third Annual Collin Leadership Policy Summit

- More than **300 people attended** the event which was held on Nov. 13 at the Frisco Campus.
- The half-day summit explored regional topics of interest, leading discussions about upcoming policy changes and opportunities in Collin County and beyond.
- Seven panel discussions were presented, including the keynote address, "Building a Stronger Workforce," where panelists
  Mike Morath, Texas Education Agency commissioner of education, and Dr. Harrison Keller, University of North Texas president, spoke about the importance of partnerships to strengthen the workforce for students and future leaders of our communities.

- Collin College **honored students**, **faculty**, and **staff military veterans** with its annual **All Services Military Appreciation Ball** at McKinney Campus and several special events at the Frisco Campus.
- The Military Appreciation Ball was held on Nov. 9, with dinner, dancing, and keynote speaker Dan Lombardo.
- The public was welcomed to visit several activities at the Frisco
  Campus between Nov. 11-15, including a World War I Mobile Museum
  that featured interactive and educational displays providing unique
  opportunities to learn about the history of WWI and its lasting impact.
- A Wall of Honor, created by the college's art professors was also on display at the Frisco Campus Library. This exhibit showcased images of students, faculty, and staff military veterans who are now members of Collin College's community.
- Other veteran-centered events were also held at Veterans Resource Centers throughout the district, including lunches and other treats provided for student veterans.


