1. Collin College Foundation hosts an honorary classroom naming for a Princeton Police Department officer

- The **Officer Nancy Dominguez Law Enforcement Classroom** naming ceremony was held on Feb. 10 at the Public Safety Training Center, honoring Officer Nancy Dominguez, who was killed in an off-duty car crash on April 20, 2024.
- Family, friends, and community leaders attended to commemorate her legacy and the establishment of the **Officer Nancy Dominguez Memorial Scholarship** by the **Princeton Community Development Corporation** and **Collin College Foundation**. The scholarship aims to support Collin College students pursuing careers in criminal justice.
- Officer Dominguez's family expressed gratitude for the recognition, highlighting the significance of the classroom as a symbol of **her commitment to education and service** in the field of law enforcement.
