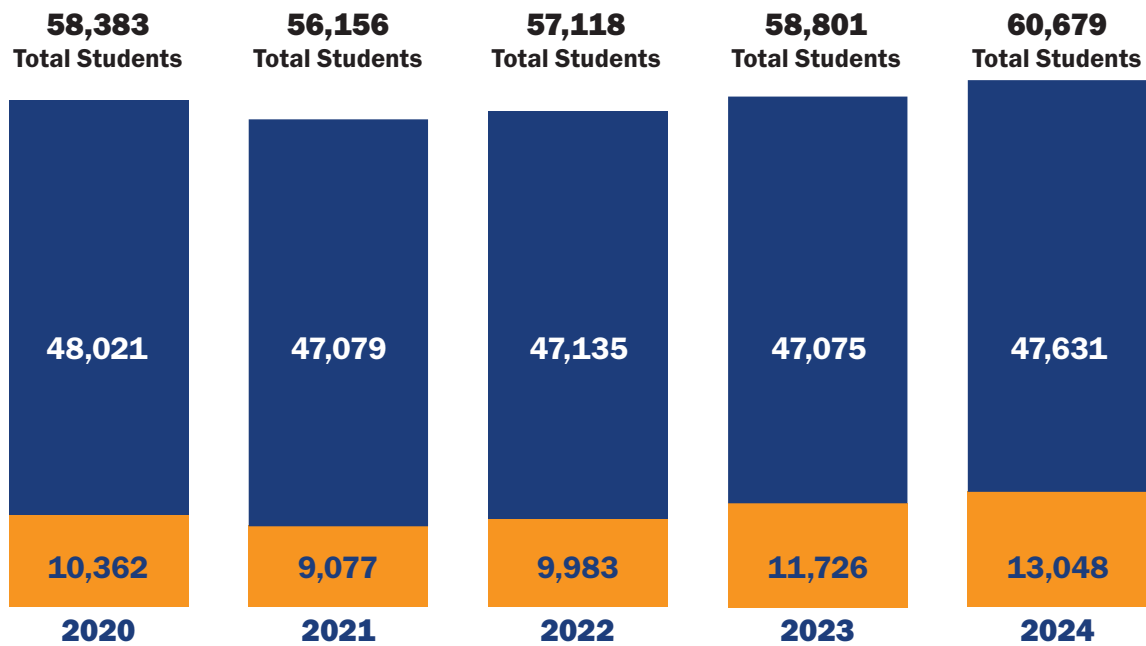

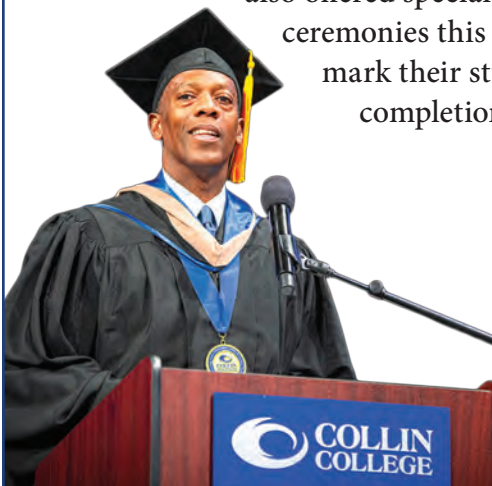

on May 15. The college held two ceremonies, and several degree programs also offered specialized ceremonies this month to mark their students' completions.



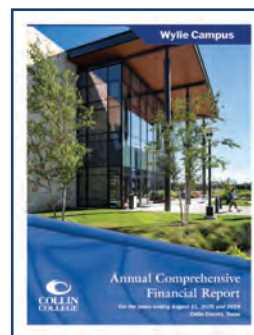
