- Complete online application at: www.applytexas.org. Even students who have studied in the United States several years, must apply as an INTERNATIONAL TRANSFER STUDENT if they hold an F-1 visa. Look carefully at the list of documents needed for admission and send them in a timely manner. Applications will not be processed until all documents and test scores are in your admissions file.
- Students, whose native language is not English, may meet the English proficiency requirement through one of the following paths:
 - 1. A waiver granted by the International Admissions Office if a student has attended a U.S. high school or college for at least two years, has completed English 1301 and 1302 with a grade of C or better at a Texas institution, OR has completed high school in a country on the English-proficiency-exempt list, http://www.depts.ttu.edu/gradschool/admissions/international/exempt-countries.php
 - 2. Submit one of the following exam scores. It should be less than 2-years-old.
 - a. TOEFL: internet-based exam, minimum 79; paper-based exam, minimum 550
 - b. IELTS: minimum 6.5
 - c. Pearson Test of Academic English: minimum 60
 - d.Cambridge: CAE, B or better; CPE, C or better
- ☑ Applicants must provide the following academic records in the original language and a certified English translation:
 - 1. Official secondary school transcripts, grades 9-12.
 - 2. Results of secondary level external examinations on examination board letterhead.
 - 3. Official transcripts from any university-level studies already completed.
